LUBERON was well placed for a half mile, rallied three wide on the second turn when roused, pushed to the front leaving the furlong marker and held on despite not switching leads. MORTON OWEN set all the pace for six furlongs, responded to urging to the stretch, could not stall the winner but had enough left to save the place. BARACHO was allowed to settle early, advanced on the backstretch, raced three wide and loomed a factor into the stretch but lost his punch in the late stages. VEZUVIY chased the pace two wide to the second turn, remained off the rail to the stretch but came up empty in the drive. FORM A POSSE broke a step slow, trailed the field to the stretch and did not rally. SOUND'O GLORY prompted the runnerup for six furlongs while two wide then tired.
