**Footnotes**

RED DOG broke in stride and controlled all of the pace, took a long lead into the stretch but was all out to last. MAYBE TUESDAY was not asked for speed early while racing just off the rail, commenced his bid on the second turn, was blocked and steadied from the five sixteenths to inside the quarter pole then unleashed a powerful run once clear in the stretch. HOT TUB AARON was always forwardly placed while three wide to the backstretch, moved up two wide on the second turn and finished steadily. SOUL GIANT was away poorly and lagged to the second turn, angled out three wide into the stretch and finished willingly. CLEARLYLUCKYGUY stalked the pace two then three wide but failed to respond on the second turn. ALMOST FOOLISH raced unhurried to the second turn, came three wide into the stretch but did not rally. COLE IS THE MAN prompted the pace from off the rail to the head of the lane and weakened. TOPAKI saved ground to no avail. SHARP UPBEAT was well placed from the inside to the second turn then had little left.
