DANAMORADA (BRZ) was forwardly placed to the half, came two wide to the stretch, rallied to the front a furlong out then held under steady urging. MISS RAINIER was shuffled back into the first turn and settled to the half, rallied inside on the second turn, shifted out into the stretch then finished willingly late. OLE CHERYL had good speed, set the pace to the second turn, saved ground to the stretch, was collared by the winner in mid stretch but stayed on stubbornly. TEA DANCING had no speed for a half, was asked to rally into the second turn, angled out five wide into the stretch then closed willingly through the drive. DISTANT CHARM was allowed to settle to the half, came two wide to the stretch then also closed steadily to the line. MARTIKA TIANNA was three wide to the backstretch, offered a bid into the second turn, got fanned four wide to the stretch, rallied to loom boldly to mid stretch then flattened out late. ANDREA'S WISH tracked the leaders to the half, came three wide to the stretch then lacked a closing response. ONE CHARMING DEVIL had no speed, was outside of TEA DANCING on the second turn and was forced out six wide into the stretch then came up empty in the lane. FANTASTIC CAREER settled mid pack to the half then lacked a response when roused. BLUE CAY saved ground to no avail.
