GAVEL set the pace from off the rail to the second turn, responded to mid stretch then dug in doggedly to hold. HUNTER CREEK was three wide to the backstretch, settled to the half, bid into the second turn, was fanned four wide to the stretch then was making up ground belatedly. MR MUNSEY was rank and fighting the rider to the middle of the first turn, settled on the backstretch, bid three wide to the stretch but lost his punch in the final furlong. SUNDARBAN attended the pace inside the winner for six furlongs, was outkicked to mid stretch and came up empty late. WALKER RD. was four wide early, tracked the pace to the second turn, had to circle rivals five wide to the stretch then did not rally.
