ROYAL TERESA was quickest and set the pace to the half, met a bid from FULLA VINK (NZ) and edged away again into the stretch then was under steady urging to the line. ALMOND BLOSSOM tracked the pace from the rail to the second turn, bid inside to the stretch and was making some progress to the wire. MILLIGRAM was three wide to the backstretch and settled to the half, tried to rally two wide on the second turn but flattened out late. FULLA VINK (NZ) prompted the pace outside the winner to the half, was asked for run and briefly looked a factor into the second turn but weakened in the drive. ALMIDDINA (IRE) was in tight behind ALMOND BLOSSOM and had to steady off heels into the first turn, settled to the half, bid three wide on the second turn but came up empty in the drive. LAND TAX steadied behind ALMIDDINA (IRE) into the first turn and was not a factor. FLYING ALIBI had no speed, made a mid race bid three wide to the second turn then gave out after six furlongs.
