TO THE BATCAVE was in good position to the turn then was caught behind rivals and forced to wait for room from the quarter pole to the three sixteenths, slipped through a tight hole between rivals nearing mid stretch and shot to the front then held driving. MARIAH MARINA was outsprinted early, bid three wide at the three eighths then got fanned out five wide to the stretch, was on even terms with the winner to mid stretch but was outfinished by that one late. SUCH FORTUNE was sent for speed in the early stages, set a pressured pace to the stretch, remained in front to mid stretch then weakened in the final sixteenth. MISS TRIPLE PLAY tracked the pace to the turn, rallied three then four wide to the stretch, loomed to mid stretch but hung in the final sixteenth. UPSIZED stalked the leaders to the turn, tried to rally three wide to the stretch but lacked the needed response. P TOWN TOPPER was outsprinted, trailed to the turn and saved ground but was not a threat. WILD GYPSIE prompted the pace from the rail to the stretch then tired. JUMPIN JANET tracked the leaders to the turn, was caught four wide to the stretch and gave way through the drive.
