BUFFALO BILLY (IRE) chased the pace to the turn, bid two wide to mid turn then eased out three wide to the stretch, rallied when set down for the drive, took a short lead late and held on. INDIAN BOBBY hesitated and broke slow then was also slow to find a comfortable stride, trailed while three wide into the turn had to swing out six deep into the stretch but rallied smartly once straightened and closed with a rush to just miss. HE'S A SURE CALL was outsprinted to the turn, bid three then four wide to the stretch and closed willingly late. SOLD SHORT attended the pace from the rail to the stretch, responded to deep stretch then got outfinished in the final stages. APOLLO'S LEGACY stalked the pace early, was pushed out five deep into the stretch then could not make an impact late. GO GREEN GO had good speed, dueled outside of SOLD SHORT to the stretch, stayed on to mid stretch then tired.
