Footnotes

LAST TIME AROUND broke a bit slow and was slow into stride, commenced his bid once on the turn, circled rivals five wide to the stretch, collared the leaders in mid stretch and edged clear driving. ROSE'S LAD was always within striking distance of the dueling leaders, moved up outside those rival on the turn, challenged for the lead leaving the furlong pole, took command but could not stall the winner. ALABAMA BOY was permitted to settle early, came three wide to the stretch, rallied to mid stretch then lacked room between horses and lost his chance. DANNY JAMES dueled outside PLEASURE TO RIDE into the stretch and faded. PLEASURE TO RIDE dueled from off the rail to the furlong pole and weakened. DELMANDO lagged early, saved ground to the stretch, angled out past the furlong pole and came on. WICKED CASH raced unhurried early, was four wide on the turn and failed to respond. BOLLY stalked the pace early, was two wide on the turn and came up empty. GEORGIE BABY tracked the leaders from the rail, was in a bit tight into the turn and fell back steadily.
