**Footnotes**

ADRIATIC MOON broke alertly but was not asked for speed and raced in hand to the turn, was sent up around the field to be five wide into the lane, took command a furlong out and drew clear driving. TITRANIUM was never too far back, raced just off the rail on the turn, was blocked behind a wall of horses into the stretch, dropped inside HEROISM once straightened for the drive and finished steadily. SILENT SALUTE was void of speed to the turn, came three wide into the lane, angled widest for the drive and closed willingly. HEROISM set the pace outside CONCLUSIVE to the turn, met bids into the lane but gradually weakened. TRAINSPOTTING was permitted to settle early, advanced three wide and between horses at the quarter pole but could not sustain his rally. BEAM ME UP TOPPER tracked the leaders from the outset, moved up between horses and four wide to loom a factor into the lane but flattened out. CONCLUSIVE dueled inside to the turn and faded steadily.
