TWO PARTS broke on top and set all of the pace while crossing to the inside, drew clear on the turn and into the stretch then held his advantage under brief urging only. HE'S A SURE CALL was not asked for speed early, saved ground on the turn and finished in a mild rally but was never a serious threat. GOOD MOJO chased the winner two wide to the stretch then could not match strides. TOTHEMOONANDBEYOND broke a bit slow and had no speed. MR. DAY TRIPPER stalked the winner three wide to the turn and gave way.
