NAVA NATALY was among the leaders early but got squeezed and forced to steady at the seven sixteenth when MAZAMA SUNRISE came out slightly, recovered and bid three wide to the stretch then closed determinedly late to be along in time. CURLY GIRLY attended the pace outside horses to the turn, was three wide to the stretch, pushed clear to mid stretch then could not hold off the winner. MAZAMA SUNRISE was hustled along inside rivals and dueled to the half mile pole, came out slightly and squeezed off the winner, responded from the rail to the stretch but was tiring in the final furlong. CINDARI was outsprinted to the turn then was fanned out to the five path into the stretch and did not offer a late response. MEDICINE GAL had no speed and saved ground to no avail. BILLIEJEANTHISISIT was on the pace from between horses to the stretch then gave way.
