FU PEG HE RAT took back early and raced unhurried to the second turn from off the rail, rallied quickly entering the lane, collared SUNDANCE KIDDO leaving the furlong pole and drew off driving. SUNDANCE KIDDO set all of the pace from off the rail to the furlong pole, could not match strides with the winner but held well for the place. MEMONNIER lagged early from the rail, angled five wide on the second turn, rallied into the stretch but flattened out. COUNT IT ALL JOY stalked the pace two wide to the stretch then gave way inside. ROBS HERO settled early from the outside and failed to respond while four wide on the second turn. MOSCATO saved ground to no avail. LANG FIELD was a bit slow into stride then raced up four wide on the first turn to prompt the pace for six furlongs and gave out.
