**Footnotes**

BIG COZZ stalked the pace of PROUD ILLUSION from the outside, moved up to take a slight edge nearing the five-sixteenths marker, vied with EDDIE CODDANA through the lane and drew clear of that rival through the final yards. EDDIE CODDANA was away alertly to chase the leaders from the outside, moved up to engage the winner approaching the stretch but could not match strides with that foe through the final yards. RED SEA showed no early speed, moved between rivals nearing the five-sixteenths pole, angled inside into the lane, reached a striking position in mid-stretch but lacked the needed late response. DIAMOND TOUCH was off a step slow, lacked early speed, raced wide through the second turn and failed to rally. PROUD ILLUSION sprinted clear soon after the start, saved ground while setting the pace and weakened after going five furlongs.
