### Footnotes

DIAMOND OF BLUE moved up after the break to prompt SHERMAN BARTLEBORT for the lead, advanced outside that rival in hand to gain command on the turn, then responded in the stretch and held driving. DOWNTOWN C. T. was permitted to settle early, moved closer from the inside on the turn, entered the lane directly behind the winner and lacked room briefly, tried to drop inside that rival but had to come back out, finally slipped through a narrow opening inside RECONSTRUCTION and rallied gamely near the wire to be getting to the winner. RECONSTRUCTION stalked the pace three wide throughout but lacked the needed late response. ROCKSPRINGS TEXAS was not asked for speed early, raced three wide on the turn and finished evenly. SHERMAN BARTLEBORT sprinted clear early from the rail but had little left once headed by the winner on the turn.
