CRUZIN THE HARBOR broke cleanly and dueled outside BRASS AND GOLD to the the quarter pole, responded when called upon to take a clear lead in the upper stretch and held driving. HEDGER was very slow into stride, but offered an impressive bid by circling rivals five wide on the turn, loomed a bold factor once in the stretch but flattened out in the drive. PROSPERO lacked good early speed, raced just off the rail on the turn and finished steadily. FOUR TO SCORE broke alertly and stalked the dueling leaders three wide to the stretch and faltered. SHIMMERING WILDCAT tracked the pace four wide to the head of the lane and weakened. GOTHAM LOUIE lacked early speed, or a closing response while in the three path entering the stretch. BRASS AND GOLD rushed up inside to duel the winner to the stretch then had little left.
