MAJESTIC AFLEET was allowed to settle in stride early, saved ground through the run, reached the fore with a sixteenth to run and held off the closing COST OF FREEDOM to prevail. COST OF FREEDOM was never far back, raced wide through the turn and finished with good energy to be gaining late. STREET CAR duelled for the early advantage from the inside, opened a clear margin into the lane but could not resist the closers in the drive. LORNEFIVEHUNDRED pressed the pace from the outside, moved up to engage the leaders nearing the five-sixteenths pole and gave way thereafter. MASTER CHEF was away alertly to dispute the pace from between foes, checked while retreating through the final sixteenth and continued to give way. MAIDENS JUSTICE lacked early foot, raced wide through the turn and failed to rally. BOB'S BIG SECRET raced off the pacesetters from the outside and weakened after going a half.
