LITTLE ESTHER raced up after the break to dispute the lead with SUNE while well in hand, responded into the lane to take a clear lead then just did last. HER EMINENCE broke alertly then was permitted to slip back off the leaders, advanced inside on the turn to rally into the stretch, angled outside the winner in mid stretch and just failed to get up. ANOTHER VARIETY stalked the pace three wide from the outset, advanced to challenge from between horses on the turn and into the stretch and slackened. GONETHELAKE stalked the pace from the extreme outside, loomed a bold factor four wide into the stretch but slackened in the late going. HERMOSA POINT settled early, saved ground but could not threaten. SLUMBER PARTY was never a serious factor. SUNE emerged from between horses after the break to duel outside the winner to the stretch then stopped.
