Footnotes

WHISPERING DIXIE drifted inward shortly after the start then settled from the two path for a half mile, rallied nearing the second turn while circling rivals four wide, dueled for the lead to mid stretch then dug in gamely and edged clear late. FEED A FEVER was forced out by ROXY on the first turn, stalked the leaders to the half, rallied three wide and dueled the winner to mid stretch but was bested in the final furlong and just saved second. QUIET ADVICE was settled for a half mile, bid three wide on the second turn then closed ground in the stretch but could not threaten the winner and missed the place. PATSY'S LIL BUDDY had speed to the backstretch then settled to the half, came two wide to the stretch but could not make an impact in the drive. ROXY was rank and hard to place into the first turn, shifted out while pulling the rider to the backstretch, dueled three wide to the second turn, remained a factor to mid stretch then tired. ONE FOR THE MONEY had speed for five furlongs then gave out.
