MR. MONKEY JONES took back early and raced unhurried to the turn, angled to the three path into the stretch, rallied steadily and was up late. MAJESTIC AFLEET was permitted to settle early but was never far back, rallied from just off the rail into the stretch, took command in mid stretch but could not quite stall the winner. SPIRIT TO WIN raced close up from the inside early, slipped back slightly on the upper turn and angled four wide to circle the leaders into the stretch, took command leaving the furlong pole but slackened late. BARREL KNOT dueled two wide into the lane and gave way leaving the furlong pole. CABO CHICO was well placed early, raced three wide on the turn and failed to rally. PLASMA BEAM dueled from the inside into the stretch and gave way. SUMMER STITCH could not keep up.
