Footnotes

VEILLIT' never far back to the second turn, was roused three then four wide to the stretch, took a short lead to mid stretch then held under steady urging. WHOS CALLING NOW was allowed to settle for a half mile, bid two wide on the second turn, was steered out in upper stretch for room then closed steadily in the final furlong. KATIEINTHEFASTLANE prompted the pace for a half, bid inside of EASY DAY to contest the pace on the second turn, dueled to mid stretch but weakened in the final sixteenth. EASY DAY set the pace to the backstretch, was engaged leaving the half mile pole, raced two then three wide to the stretch, continued to duel to mid stretch then gave way. HEART'S MUSIC was fanned out four wide on the first turn, settled to the half, tried to rally from the two path to the stretch but lacked a closing response. TUSCAN MOON was forced out five wide to the backstretch, chased the pace for five furlongs then gave way.
