STAKES Berkeley Breeders' Cup H. Grade 3 - Thoroughbred

FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$75 each to accompany the nomination or by supplementary nomination of \$1,500 by Noon, Sunday March 21, 2004. \$375 to pass the entry box and \$375 additional to start, with \$75,000 Guaranteed and an additional \$25,000 from Breeders' Cup Fund for Breeders' Cup eligibles only. The host association's monies to be divided 55% to the winner, 20% to second, 15% to third, 7.5% to fourth and 2.5% to fifth. Breeders' Cup monies also correspondingly divided providing a Breeders' Cup nominee has finished in an awarded position. Any Breeders' Cup Fund monies not awarded will revert back to the Fund. This race will not be divided. The starters will be determined at that time with preference given to Breeders' Cup nominees only of equal racing quality or weight assignment (respective of sex and weight for age).

Preference to Non-Breeders' Cup nominees follow the same stipulation. A trophy will be presented to the owner of the winner by Breeders' Cup Ltd. Closed Thursday, March 18, 2004 with 11 nominations.

SNORTER broke alertly and tracked the pace from the inside under patient handling, remained inside when called upon near the quarter pole, came through a bit tight quarters at the three sixteenths, challenged leaving the furlong pole and gradually proved best. YOUNGOTTAWANNA set all of the pace from just off the rail, turned back repeated challenges to mid stretch but could not hold the winner late in a game try. TASTE OF PARADISE broke a bit outward but quickly raced up outside and prompted the pace three wide, offered his best bid into the lane but slackened in the late stages. GOLD RUCKUS took back early but was always within striking distance, advanced to challenge four wide on the second turn then lacked the needed late response. JETS FAN was never far back while racing just outside the winner to the second turn, could not keep up into the lane, swung to the outside but could make little impact
