Footnotes

I CEE'S A TIGER chased the pace to the turn, bid three wide to the stretch, rallied when set down, did not switch leads through the drive but dug in determinedly and got the nod. WETHERBEE LAKE stalked the leader to the turn, saved ground and followed MAHALO PRINCESS into the stretch, shifted outside that one in upper stretch, responded when roused, also failed to switch leads through the final furlong but finished willingly to just miss. MAHALO PRINCESS set the pace to the turn, was off the rail to mid turn then shifted in and raced inside through a long drive, stayed gamely to the final jump but also missed. SUKARA was outsprinted to the turn, came three then four wide to the stretch and was gaining ground belatedly. LIFE'S A THRILL had no speed, raced off the rail on the turn then closed a gap without threatening. JUST AFTER SUNSET had no speed and was not a factor. ANCIENT ARTIFACT stalked the leader two wide to the stretch then tired.
