GO MOJAVE GO stalked the pace in hand to the turn, rallied two wide to the stretch, edged away to mid stretch and held under steady urging. HANDPICKED BUD tracked the pace to the turn, was two wide to the stretch then could not impact the winner but bested the rest. ARGENTO'S FROST stalked the pace outside the winner and three wide to the stretch, made a bid to mid stretch then lost his punch late. EL TIO FERNANDO had no speed, raced two wide to the stretch and made up a bit of ground late. GRAND PIONEER was chasing to the turn, raced three wide to the stretch but lacked a closing response. LEO THE COP had no speed, bid two wide to mid turn, swung out five deep into the stretch then went evenly late. SUMMER PAD set the pace from the rail to the stretch then gave way.
