VOICE OF DESTINY broke very alertly and gained a narrow advantage into the first turn from the rail, continued to duel from the inside into the stretch, lost the advantage nearing the furlong pole but came back on, brushed twice with MR. DOUBLEDOWN nearing the sixteenth pole then edged clear late. MR. DOUBLEDOWN raced up to duel with the winner two wide throughout, forged to the front nearing the furlong pole but slackened in the deep stretch after brushing with the winner. TWILIGHT AFFAIR stalked the dueling leaders from the inside into the stretch but lacked the needed response. HOLLYCOMBE also tracked the leaders just outside TWILIGHT AFFAIR to the stretch and gave out. WEGOTOHAVEHARTE settled early while four wide on the first turn, remained out on the second turn and did not rally. SOLE CHE SORGI (IRE) had no early speed, tried to rally while two wide on the second turn but never reached contention. FUTURAL broke in the air and well behind the field but had no speed in a dull try. DANCING AFLEET showed brief speed and stopped. The rider aboard MR. DOUBLEDOWN lodged an objection against the winner for interference in the stretch but the stewards allowed the original finish to stand.
