HE DID was quickest early and raced clear in the opening quarter, set all the pace to the stretch then dug in determinedly and held in a desperate decision. R SEEKER was closest to the winner while two wide to the stretch, responded when set down and made a late surge to just miss. RICK THE BARTENDER bobbled in the opening strides, recovered but was outsprinted to the turn, raced two wide to the stretch then closed willingly in the final furlong. FUELED BY KAFFINE had no speed, bid two then three wide to the stretch and was also closing ground steadily late. GO BAROQUE chased the top two to the turn, saved ground to the stretch then could not muster the needed late response. MOVE OVER MARINO was just inside of GO BAROQUE to the turn, dropped back to the stretch and gave out through the drive.
