WHILLY PINK stalked the pace two wide to the stretch, rallied when set down, got to terms with the runnerup in mid stretch, switched leads at the sixteenth marker and dug in to inch away in the final stages. HOPE 'N PRAY pressed the pace to the turn, bid two wide to the quarter pole, took a short lead into the stretch, was engaged by the winner a furlong out and dug in determinedly but was nipped. BINGO THE BIRDDOG broke a bit slow, had no speed, raced two wide to the stretch but could not threaten the top two. LOS BAMBINOS was away a bit slow, chased the pace three wide to the stretch but lacked a closing response. TORRE FARO chased the pace to the turn, was asked for more three wide but weakened in mid stretch. SARGENT STADANKO also was away a bit slow, had no speed and was not a factor. KITTEN MOBILE flashed speed to the turn, responded to the quarter pole then was overtaken and gave way through the stretch.
