SIMPLY SHARP took command into the first turn and drew off to a long lead once on the backstretch, maintained his advantage into the stretch but was fully extended to last. DASHING lagged early from the rail and raced unhurried to the second turn, angled three wide into the stretch and closed steadily. MY T QUICK was forwardly placed from the inside throughout but lacked a closing response. CAVA KAVIA stalked two wide to the second turn and failed to rally. PROMETHEUS BULL raced outside a three horse spread into the lane and did not respond. FELLOW ELDERADO settled early, raced two wide and between horses to the stretch and did not rally. BEAU DIABLO lacked early speed, was four wide on the second turn and never reached contention.
