MO PLEASURE lacked good early speed, advanced from off the rail on the turn split rivals from the quarter pole to the upper stretch, rallied to the lead past mid stretch and won driving. TIGER MASTER stalked the pace from the outset, rallied three wide into the stretch to take command and drew clear but could not stall the winner. U. R. BEAT settled early, moved up four wide on the turn and flattened out. GRATIS stalked the pace three wide to mid turn and weakened. RAT CITY JOE was off a step slow but quickly rushed to the lead, led to the upper stretch and gave out. VOLTAR saved ground to no avail. WARRENS GOOD STORM was never a factor. PURGESTEIN dueled from the rail and stopped.
