TEACE R. N. emerged from between horses after the break to duel for the lead while dropping to the rail, continued to duel into the stretch then was put to a drive leaving the furlong pole and drew clear. STORM KISU unhurried early, commenced her rally into the turn, came four wide to the stretch to loom a bold factor a furlong out but lost much of her punch while gamely gaining the place. OLYMPIC METTLE dueled outside the winner to the furlong pole then could not match strides. DREAMY MEETING settled early, shifted three wide on the turn but lacked a closing response. FIREINTHEMEADOW lacked early speed, came two wide to the stretch and finished in a mild rally against all but the winner. WILDCAT ORCHID stalked the dueling leaders three wide to the stretch then came up empty. SLICK TRICK raced up after the break to be with the leaders from the inside in the opening furlong but steadily faded. WIND TRAIL ducked in after a slow start and never reached contention.
