SANTANO sprinted clear in the opening stages under restraint, maintained his advantage into the stretch then was all out to last. TONY'S ROYALTY chased the winner from the outset and was making some late impact. TEXAS HILL settled early, raced four wide to the stretch and closed steadily. TIGER TOWN stalked the pace three wide but lacked the needed response. BIG LEAGUE settled early, saved ground but did not threaten. DANCE WITH PRIDE raced unhurried early, came two wide to the stretch and closed from the extreme outside. FANCY M. D. saved ground to no avail. NINETENTHSOFTHELAW lacked good early speed, raced four wide on the turn and never threatened.
