### Footnotes

DUKE OF DOOM was not asked for speed early while three wide to the backstretch, dropped to the inside nearing the half mile pole, remained inside on the second turn to reach serious contention then offered a bold late response to get up from the rail in the final jump. VOTE OF APPROVAL took command into the first turn and set all of the pace from the inside, edged clear at the furlong pole then just failed to last. WELCOME HOME RYAN prompted VOTE OF APPROVAL from the outside into the stretch, could not quite go with that one nearing the furlong pole but kept to his task in the lane. SWORN TO SECRECY settled early, raced three wide to the stretch and failed to rally. CODY PEAK lagged early from off the rail, raced two wide on the second turn, eased out once in the stretch and closed a minor gap. MAGIC OF THE MOON was well positioned from off the rail throughout but failed to respond while racing in the two path into the stretch. MUTINY BAY took a favorable striking position from the outside early, remained three wide on the second turn but came up empty. GAME EVENT saved ground to no avail. CARNIVAL CANDYMAN was never a factor. DIABLO RUN was permitted to settle early from off the rail, tried to rally four wide on the second turn but had nothing left.
