

HUDSON LANDING had the best speed, set a pressured pace to the second turn, responded to a bid from the runnerup to the stretch then kept to task and inched away late. POSSE POWER pressured the winner for five furlongs, offered his best try mid way on the second turn, was outkicked to mid stretch then saved second. AWESOME GEM had no speed and settled for a half, got fanned four wide while offering a bid on the second turn then finished with interest. DREAM NETTIE settled mid pack for five furlongs, rallied three wide on the second turn to reach contention then could not sustain the needed response. RENDEZVOUS chased the leaders to the second turn, moved up inside to briefly loom a threat on the second turn but lost his punch in the stretch. CAYAMBE tracked the pace from between horses for five furlongs, bid two wide to the stretch but lacked a closing rally. SIR AL (IRE) had no speed, raced off the rail on the second turn and came up empty when asked in the drive. METEORE went wrong into the first turn, was pulled up and vanned off.
