Footnotes

BIG SWIG was permitted to settle in the early going while racing off the rail, offered his bid three wide into the stretch to gain command, dueled with ACKMAN in the drive, was bumped by that rival late while losing the lead but got back up. ACKMAN raced unhurried to the second turn, rallied four wide into the stretch to be challenging for command at the furlong pole, drifted in late and bumped with BIG SWIG nearing the wire and was out nodded. GREAT RISING STAR was forwardly placed from the outset, moved up two wide on the second turn to offer his bid between horses then slackened in the lane. POINT AND SHOOT showed no speed from just off the rail to the second turn then found his best stride late. LETHAL INTENT drew off to a long lead on the backstretch but gave up the advantage into the second turn and had little left. The stewards posted the inquiry and the rider aboard ACKMAN lodged an objection against the winner for interference in the deep stretch. However, after reviewing the incident, the stewards ruled that ACKMAN was the aggressor and allowed the original finish to stand.
