Footnotes

SUNDAY HEADLINE was well placed to the second turn, bid three wide to the stretch then finished willingly to wear down SUNDAY COMIC for the win. SUNDAY COMIC was on the pace from the outset despite being fanned five wide, dueled outside a rival on the second turn, took a short lead leaving the furlong grounds but could not stall the winner while best of the rest. TWO BUCKS TO WIN also dueled on the pace for six furlongs, responded from the rail to the stretch, had the rider drop his whip at the head of the lane then tired in the final furlong. GANGSTER OF LOVE was rank and took up sharply into the first turn, settled for a half, came three wide to the stretch then made a belated bid in the last eighth. CLUTCH stalked the leaders to the half, saved ground on the second turn but came up empty in the drive. FULL'S KRIS S. settled mid pack to the second turn, got fanned out four deep to the stretch then lacked a closing response. ALOHA MR. HAND tracked the leaders for five furlongs, offered his best try three wide on the second turn but weakened in the stretch. GREAT RISING STAR had no speed and was not a factor.
