COOKIELAMOUR broke alertly then took back just off the dueling leaders and raced under patient handling to the second turn, rallied three wide into the lane, responded from between horses at the furlong pole and edged clear driving. BEEZAROO was unhurried early from the rail but was always within striking position, continued to save ground to the stretch, shifted out once in the lane and closed steadily. LA PEARLA was not asked for speed early while three wide to the backstretch, swung out four wide on the second turn, rallied to the lead near the furlong pole but could not go with the winner in the lane. LIKA lagged early from off the rail, angled five wide into the stretch but lacked the needed response. STRAIT JAZZ eased outside HIGH CALIBER on the first turn and pressed that rival for the lead to the head of the lane and weakened. SMILES CONTAGIOUS was void of early speed, raced just off the rail on the second turn and failed to reach serious contention. HIGH CALIBER set the pace while crossing to the inside, maintained a narrow lead after six furlongs but came up empty once in the stretch.
