Footnotes

HEAT STREAKER was forwardly placed from the outset off the rail, circled the leaders four wide on the second turn to gain command in the upper stretch, drifted out under left handed urging at the furlong pole, was straightened the drifted out again inside the sixteenth pole under left handed urging and just prevailed. UNUSUAL MEETING lagged early from off the rail, commenced his bid two wide on the second turn, angled widest for the drive and finished steadily with the winner crossing in front of him late and just missed. MINISTER VIVENDI settled early three wide, raced two wide on the second turn to advance to the stretch but flattened out in the late stages. GALLANT CHARM pressed the pace from the inside early, eased outside AS GOOD AS GOLD once on the backstretch and continued to prompt that rival into the stretch, slackened but finished gamely in the drive. AS GOOD AS GOLD set the pace from the outset, crossed inside into the backstretch and led nearing the stretch then faded. STREET MAVEN was well placed early from the rail, raced three wide on the second turn and failed to rally. HIGHER MANDATE was not a factor and was eased in the stretch. The rider aboard UNUSUAL MEETING lodged an objection against the winner for interference nearing the finish. After reviewing the incident the stewards allowed the original finish to stand.
