HUDSON LANDING broke alertly and stalked the pace three wide to the stretch, responded once set down to gain command at the furlong pole and won driving. PHOTO SHOPPED prompted the pace from the rail throughout but was outfinished by the winner. NONIOS settled early from the inside, raced in traffic two wide on the second turn then did not find his finishing stride until leaving the furlong pole. WHEN WE MET tracked from the inside, remained inside on the second turn and fell back to last but kept to his task and came back late. WARNING SONG stalked four wide to the stretch and failed to respond. CONTROL SEEKER settled early then failed to respond while four wide on the second turn. HEROICALLY raced three and four wide throughout and was never a serious factor. NORTHERN INDY gained command on the first turn to set the pace from off the rail, was a bit rank on the backstretch and had little for the drive.
