MUNNINGS SISTER was quickly in front to set all of the pace from just off rail, responded in the lane and just did hold. HARD SPUN SECRETS was never too far back, raced just off the rail on the turn then closed gamely inside the winner to just miss. HARD TO PLEASE was well placed early without need of urging, came four wide to the stretch and closed too late. RIBOT BELLE was within easy striking distance in the early stages, rallied three wide into the stretch and lost some of her punch. TRIBAL DELIGHT prompted the winner from the outside to the furlong pole but lacked the needed closing punch. BILLIE'S BLING settled early, raced two wide on the turn and was gaining late. LA CHISPA lacked early speed, saved ground to the stretch and was making up ground late. RUN THE BLUES AWAY settled early, was three wide on the turn but could not reach serious contention.
