AWESOME PRINCE chased the winner into the stretch then proved no match. REFORMED stalked the pace three and two wide and weakened. CALLDEROLL was forwardly placed, raced three wide throughout and did not rally. GAME PERFECT lagged early, advanced three wide on the second turn but could not sustain that bid. I'M THE GOLD was never a factor. RIVER VISTA saved ground to no avail then pulled up lame and was vanned off. AKOYA BEACH could not keep up.
