Footnotes

MY SECRET WEAPON was outsprinted early, bid three wide at the three eighths, swung out four deep into the stretch then closed steadily through the final furlong to be along in time. SONG OF SABIA broke a bit slow then was urged early and raced past the winner to the turn, responded three wide to the stretch, took a short lead a furlong out but could not hold off MY SECRET WEAPON late. EDUCATED TASK had no speed, raced two then three wide to the stretch but could not make an impact in the drive while up for the show. SWIM SUIT MODEL tracked the pace from the rail to the quarter pole, came out for room in upper stretch but lacked a closing response. DANCE THE DANCE contested the pace from off the rail to the stretch, drifted inward slightly and crowded GALES ACT in mid stretch then weakened. GALES ACT dueled inside of DANCE THE DANCE to the stretch, was being outrun in upper stretch and had to check when crowded at the furlong marker then stopped.
