Footnotes

AWESOME JARED was never far back while racing along the inside, angled out approaching the stretch, responded to aggressive handling and woe down SIDE TO SIDE to be edging away late. SIDE TO SIDE was away alertly to stalk the pace of SIGNATURE MOVE from the outside, moved up to take command inside the quarter but could not match strides with the winner through the final yards. C. T. ZEE lacked early speed, advanced from off the rail into the stretch, failed to menace the top two in the drive but finished with good energy. CHEVIN showed no early foot, raced wide through the second turn and did not reach contention. FOLLOWS NONE broke sharply to chase the pacesetters from the outside and gave way after going five furlong. SIGNATURE MOVE went to the front soon after the start, opened a clear lead before going a quarter, saved ground while setting the pace and readily retreated when headed.
