Footnotes

FALLING KNIFE was unhurried to the second turn, rallied inside to the stretch, angled outside of C C'S DIAMOND in mid stretch for clearance then closed steadily to be along in time. C C'S DIAMOND prompted the pace to the second turn, moved alongside REDMOND RIDGE and dueled that one to mid stretch then could not stall the winner late. REDMOND RIDGE set the pace in hand for five furlongs, responded when hooked on the second turn, remained a factor to mid stretch but was giving way late. SEE ZO GO stalked the pace three wide to the half, made a good bid three deep on the second turn to be a threat to mid stretch then tired. LUCKYWITHTHELADIES had no speed, was four wide to the backstretch, got outrun to the second turn then had nothing to offer in the drive. COURTOWN HARBOUR also had no speed and stopped after five furlongs.
