Footnotes

GATHERATTHEALTER was unhurried for a half mile, bid two wide into the second turn, eased out four wide for room into the stretch then responded to pressure in the drive and pushed past RED COATS R COMIN late. RED COATS R COMIN was on the pace while racing off the rail to the stretch, dug in to mid stretch, was headed by CROWN OF ARAGORN in deep stretch but fought back bravely while not being able to stall the winner. CROWN OF ARAGORN chased the pace to the second turn, saved ground and rallied to mid stretch, took a short lead in deep stretch but hung in the final sixteenth. DA JERSEY EXPRESS was outsprinted early and tracked the pace, bid two then three wide on the second turn but flattened out in the final furlong. STREET ROCKET had no speed, trailed to the second turn, was pushed out five deep to the stretch and lacked the needed late response. UNEXPECTED GIFT prompted the pace to the second turn, tried to rally from the two path while following the runnerup into the stretch but weakened in the final furlong.
