BRUNO'S WAGER raced up early from the rail but was shuffled back leaving the half mile pole, swung four wide into the lane and offered a quick rally to gain command just inside the furlong pole and drew clear driving. A PINT FOR MARY stalked the pace from the outside, was fanned four wide on the turn had his best bid a furlong out but could not sustain that rally. FIRE IN THE WIND dueled two wide early, was carried three wide into the lane while continuing to battle, drifted inward near the sixteenth pole while faltering. MTN RANCH WILLY stalked the pace from the outset, was boxed on the turn and forced to steady sharply at the quarter pole, recovered to rally inside to the furlong pole and lost his punch. CLOSE PURSUIT broke in stride and took a narrow lead in the opening quarter, continued to duel on the turn, drifted out slightly into the lane, gave up the advantage in the upper stretch and checked near the sixteenth pole off FIRE IN THE WIND while faltering. RENZO SEAN lagged to the stretch and came on without being a serious factor. The stewards posted the inquiry and reviewed an incident concerning FIRE IN THE WIND and CLOSE PURSUIT near the sixteenth pole. they ruled that FIRE IN THE WIND did come in slightly but the incident did not alter the ultimate finish.
