TROPICAL HEAT lagged to the second turn while racing just off the rail, commenced his bid into the stretch, shifted to the extreme outside for the drive and closed steadily to gain command late and won going away driving. DEAL BREAKER (GB) stalked the pace three wide throughout, challenged for the lead nearing the furlong pole, took command past the furlong pole but could not hold the winner. SENATOR BOB prompted the pace from the rail, steadied on the first turn but remained inside, was boxed and steadied repeatedly from the half mile pole to the quarter pole then kept to his task when room developed in the stretch in a game effort. ELUSIVE SCHEMES was never too far back while saving ground early, came three wide on the second turn and finished steadily. NINER GENIUS settled early three wide, was fanned four wide on the second turn and went evenly through the lane. LETHARGIC set all of the pace from just off the rail and weakened in the final furlong.
