### Footnotes

ROLL THE POINT was permitted to settle well off the pace early while three wide to the backstretch, moved closer into the second turn, circled three wide to the stretch to gain command once in the stretch, edged clear but was all out to hold. BLAZING DAN was quickly in front and drew off to a long lead early on the backstretch, maintained an advantage to the head of the lane then went gamely once headed. MOSCATO stalked the pace two wide from the outset, had his best bid between horses into the stretch, shifted outside ROLL THE POINT nearing the furlong pole then went evenly to the line. SMOOTH AND SAVVY saved ground to no real avail. JOHNNY THE WATCH settled early, raced two wide to the stretch while making up some ground but lacked the needed response in the final eighth.
