### Footnotes

SUMMER SUNSHINE took a slim lead from the inside into the first turn, alternated with BLAST'EM under good rating, responded in the upper stretch and held driving. BLAST'EM dueled outside the winner throughout, could not quite match strides on the second turn and upper stretch but kept to his task and held the place. B'S LUCKY STRIKE was permitted to settle from off the rail, raced unhurried to the second turn, dropped inside for the drive but lacked the needed response. MANITOGA was not asked for speed from the inside, continued to save ground on the second turn, rallied into the stretch, shifted off the rail and outside BLAST'EM near the sixteenth pole and finished steadily. SWISS CURRENCY lacked good early speed, rallied three wide on the second turn but lost his punch in the lane.
