Footnotes

TOPAKI was not asked for speed to the second turn, circled rivals four wide into the stretch, rallied steadily and was up late. LITTLE SIBERIAN set all of the pace from the inside, took his longest lead in the upper stretch then fought gamely late when challenged and just failed to last. TURBULENT CREEK lagged to the second turn, angled five wide into the stretch and closed willingly. ONE LUCKY GUY settled early, raced three wide to the stretch and finished well. MR. SATISFACTION settled early, moved up on the second turn, was blocked behind a wall of horses entering the lane, steadied for several strides then, while trying to maneuver outside DOCS SHARK ATTACK, clipped that horses heels, nearly fell then recovered and actually came on late. PICASSO BLUE stalked the pace from the rail into the stretch and weakened. DOCS SHARK ATTACK pressed the pace two wide to the stretch, had his heels clipped at the three sixteenths while tiring and faded. CAVANAGH BAY stalked th pace from the outside for six furlongs then did not respond and was not persevered with late. The stewards posted the inquiry and reviewed the incident into the stretch involving MR STAISFACTION. They ruled that MR SATISFACTION was the cause of his own trouble and allowed the original finish to stand.
