REALLY A DUTCHESS had the best speed, set all the pace off the rail to the stretch then kicked away to mid stretch and was kept to task to the line. GOINTOMYHAPPYPLACE stalked the winner to the turn, bid three wide to the stretch, was outkicked in upper stretch and failed to threaten the winner but had enough left to save the place. TRAPPERS STAR was outrun to the turn, raced two wide to the stretch then finished in a mild rally while picking off rivals. POSSE'S PRINCESS threw her head soon after the start and knocked the rider in the head, was outsprinted to the turn, raced three wide to the stretch and lacked the needed response. BIRDIE GIRL chased the winner to the turn, was fanned four wide to the stretch and did not rally. LUCK BE A LILY pressed the pace to the turn then saved ground to the stretch but weakened in the final furlong. MEETYOUATGROUION'S also chased the pace to the turn, was widest and raced five wide to the stretch then tired in the drive.
