**Footnotes**

STOP TRAFFIC broke alertly then settled just inside MISTER CRAFTY and in hand, remained inside and under a snug hold on turn and waited for room into the lane, responded quickly once a hole opened nearing the furlong pole to take command and won with plenty in reserve. WOODMAN'S DANCER stalked the pace four wide from the outset, offered her best bid leaving the furlong pole but could not match strides with the winner. FONTAL (ARG) prompted the pace three wide, led briefly in the upper stretch but was outfinished for the place. LADY TAP, slow early, raced inside to mid turn, angled out nearing the quarter pole but had an insufficient response. SHAY lacked early speed and failed to respond while four wide on the turn. AUGUST QUEEN lagged early, was fanned five wide on the turn and failed to rally. MISTER CRAFTY set all of the pace from just off the rail to the head of the lane and gave way inside. QUEEN'S BET was hustled early to be in close contact with the pace, raced in checked into the turn in traffic and had no response. FUNALLOVER was never a serious factor.
